

2025 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

PURPOSE

The Cuban American Bar Foundation ("CABF" or "CABA Foundation") is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization dedicated to providing financial assistance to Cuban-American law students and law students of all backgrounds interested in activities of importance to the Cuban-American community. Since its inception, CABF has provided scholarships for deserving law students in accredited law schools and has honored the memory of distinguished lawyers and judges by awarding scholarships in their memory.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Financial assistance is based on academic performance, leadership potential, and participation in community programs including, but not limited to, volunteer hours.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

CABF awards scholarships on the basis of a comprehensive process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include, but are not limited to, the following: Academic Accomplishments, Community Service, References, Personal Essay and Financial Need. CABF pays scholarship funds directly to the recipient. Scholarships are awarded annually. Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, gender or sexual orientation. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria.

CRITERIA

- Applicant must be a law student of Cuban heritage who has distinguished himself/herself academically and/or in service-oriented activities; **OR** any law student who has distinguished himself/herself in research, writing, community services, and/or other activities of importance to the Cuban-American community;
- Applicant must be a currently enrolled student in good academic standing at an accredited law school with at least one semester completed but not in their final semester:
 - o Incoming 1L students are ineligible;
 - o Students with a graduation date in Spring/Summer of 2025 are ineligible; and
 - o L.L.M. Students are not eligible unless enrolled in a dual-degree programs that confers both an L.LM. and J.D. concurrently.
- Applicant must submit a complete formal application for a CABF Scholarship;
- Applicant must be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States; and
- Applicant must complete and submit a <u>typed</u> Scholarship Application and provide all supporting documents listed below (i.e., resume, evidence of enrollment, etc.) no later than **June 1, 2025.**

TIMELINE

- Applications and supporting documentation are due no later than June 1, 2025 at 11:59p.m. (EST)
 NO REQUESTS FOR EXTENSIONS WILL BE GRANTED.
- Candidates may be asked for an interview by the Scholarship Committee, to be conducted in June.
- Applicants are notified if awarded a scholarship by June 27, 2025.
- CABF Scholarship recipients are expected to attend an in-person awards ceremony to be held in July (date to be announced).

APPLICATION PROCESS

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANT MUST PROVIDE:

- A <u>typed</u> Scholarship Application including the fully executed Statement of Accuracy (If any question does not apply to you in this application, please put N/A in the space).
- A competitive essay of no more than 750 words focusing on and describing in detail the activities and achievements that qualify you for a CABF Scholarship as well as a statement of your financial need. While you may explore various resources, including AI tools, in your drafting process, the final essay submission must reflect your own unique understanding, analysis, and voice to represent your critical thinking skills and writing abilities. We reserve the right to disqualify any applicant whose essay is found to violate this originality requirement.
- An updated resume to include educational and work history.
- A copy of your most recent law school transcripts

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

- Award will be made out and given directly to the recipient.
- Award will be given at the Annual Scholarship Awards Reception and all awardees are expected to attend in-person. Date for this event will be announced soon, but will be mid to late July.
- Applicant must provide their <u>correct and current mailing address.</u>
- Award amounts will be disbursed following the completion of all award requirements, including confirmation of enrollment.
